CLIMATOLOGÍA

2015 produced a magnificent harvest in the D.O. Ribera del Duero. The year was characterized by low temperatures in winter followed by a fresh spring and a dry summer with pleasantly warm days and mild nights. The contrast in temperature between night and day produced fruit with complexity and wonderful concentration. The grapes reached optimum, well-balanced maturity and boasted an abundance of fruit characteristics. The harvest was perfect for producing age-worthy wines thanks to the excellent acidity and freshness of the fruit.

ELABORACIÓN

Convento San Francisco 2015 was created using Tempranillo grapes from vineyards aged between 30 and 105 years old within the D.O. Ribera del Duero. They are situated at between 760 and 970 meters above sea level on hills and highlands within the municipalities of Quintana del Pidio, Gumiel de Izán and Fuentenebro. The various soil types are composed of sand with gravel, red clay and limestone with pebbles.

The bunches were harvested manually between the 26th and 30th September 2015, into 15kg boxes, and were received at the winery onto a double selection table.

Grapes were fermented and macerated at a controlled temperature for 20 days with daily plunging of the cap and pump overs. Aged for 16 months in 225 and 300 litre Bordeaux barrels made of French oak (80%) and American oak (20%).

A total of 57,840 750ml bottles were obtained with no filtering or clarification processes used in production.
